
Pupil Enquiry and Independent Learning

- What do you want to find out?
- Drill down deeper- what are the specific things you could find out about to do with your topic? DINOSAURS is to broad... you need to be more specific.



Example 1:

I want to find out more about <u>Scotland</u>. I want to find out about where I live- <u>Glasgow</u>.

Key questions:

- How many people live in Glasgow?
- What are the famous landmarks?
- What can you do if you are a tourist?
- Are there any famous people from Glasgow?
- Is there anything interesting in Glasgow history?
- Etc.

Example 2:

I want to find out more about <u>dinosaurs</u>. I want to find out about a <u>stegosaurus</u>.

Key questions:

- How long was it?
- What did it eat?
- What colour was it?
- When did it live on Earth?
- What happened to the dinosaurs?
- Why can't they live today?
- Etc.

Example 3:

I want to find out more about <u>The Romans</u>. I want to find out more about <u>Roman Gods</u>.

Key questions:

- What were the names of each of the Roman Gods?
- What were they all the God of?
- What did they look like?
- Who was their family?

Example 4:

I want to find out more about <u>Transport</u>. I want to find out about trains.

Key questions:

- Who built the first train?
- What different types of trains can you get?
- Are there any famous trains? (Movies, etc).
- What do different trains look like?
- How fast can a train go?
- What countries use trains?
- Etc.
