

# DEEP SPACE SPARILE





- With a waterproof black marker, trace a line around the outside of the egg.
- Fill the egg shape with lines and patterns.
- Paint the background with liquid watercolors



- With a wax crayon or oil pastel, draw a series of patterns or lines.
- Color in some parts of the drawing or shapes with crayon.
- Paint over the entire egg with one color of paint.
- Does the paint cover the crayon lines?

### **WATERPROOF MARKER**



- With a brush dipped in water, paint inside an egg shape.
- Select a color of paint and brush over the top of the wet section.
- Select another color and paint from the bottom up.
- What happens when the paint merges?
- Sprinkle salt over the wet paint.

### **WAX RESIST**




- Draw egg shapes on a piece of watercolor paper
- Using white glue or white glue mixed with India ink, trace over contour line. Add patterns.
- Fill with watercolor paints.






