Many thanks to all of the parents, carers and family members who attended our homework and family learning workshop last term. Pupils in P3-P7 will receive weekly spelling words and reading preparation, as well as monthly numeracy homework and a yearly family learning grid. Pupils in P1 and P2 will receive weekly reading and spelling tasks and rotate the book bags, family learning grids and the maths packs on a 3 weekly basis.
